Commands

Show Icon

Prompt Before Event

Exit

Show Icon (Options Menu)

Disable this option if you don't want the Scheduler's icon displayed when it runs. While the Scheduler is hidden, you can edit or change any Scheduler settings by double-clicking the Scheduler icon in the Program Manager.

Prompt Before Event (Options Menu)

Choose this option if you want to be notified before the scheduled event occurs. The Scheduler displays a dialog box that gives you 30 seconds to cancel or postpone the event. If no response is given, the event occurs at the scheduled time.

Exit (File Menu)

Quits the Scheduler. Scheduled events cannot occur under Windows if the Scheduler is closed.

Add Backup Schedule Item

Lets you schedule a previously created setup or script file. In the command's dialog box, the following options are provided:

Setup File

Select the setup file (script file) you want to schedule from the drop-down list.

Day of Week

Select the day(s) you want to schedule the event. The Scheduler indicates selected days by turning them blue and placing a border around the name of the day.

Time

Select the time you want the event to begin.

OK

Schedules the event.

Modify Backup Schedule Item

Setup File

Displays the files you can schedule in a drop-down list box.

Time

Select the time you want the scheduled event to begin.

Day of Week

Select the day(s) you want to schedule the event. The Scheduler indicates selected days by turning them blue and placing a border around the name of the day.

Delete Schedule Item

Deletes a schedule entry. Deleting a scheduled item does not delete the settings file it is based on.

Exit Central Point Scheduler dialog box

Choose **Minimize** to continue running the Scheduler so that scheduled events can be run and monitored. If you choose **OK**, your scheduled events will not be run.

Scheduler Alarm dialog box

If Prompt Before Event is enabled, the Scheduler notifies you 30 seconds before running the scheduled event. The dialog box provides the following options:

Snooze

Choose **Snooze** to close the dialog box and postpone the event for five minutes. After five minutes, the dialog box reappears and your event occurs unless you cancel or choose **Snooze** once more.

OK

Allows the event to run.

Cancel

Cancels the event.
