RECOMMENDED SYSTEM CONFIGURATION

It is advisable to have a MPC 486/33 or faster, 8MB RAM, Windows 3.1 or higher, QuickTime for Windows 2.1 (included in installer), 640x480 256 color display, and a double Speed CD-ROM drive.

To install the Macromedia Multimedia Showcase:

for Windows 3.1 users:

- 1) Insert the Showcase CD-ROM.
- 2) Open the File Manager and choose the disk drive that contains the Showcase CD-ROM.
- 3) Choose Run from the File menu.
- 4) In the Command Line field, type SETUP.EXE after the disk drive name and click OK.
- 5) Follow the instructions on screen.

for Windows 95 users:

- 1) Insert the Showcase CD-ROM.
- 2) Select and open your computer icon (on the desktop).
- 3) Select and open the CD icon.
- 4) Select and launch the setup icon.
- 5) Follow the instructions on screen.
