About the Info Desk index

The index is organized alphabetically, similarly to that of a typical book index. All topics are accessible from the index, and are cross-referenced to many subject keywords. To quickly find information on any Norton program, go to the Index tab and type in the first few letters of a word that relates to the information you're interested in.

To help you navigate, all programs support many keyboard operations. Some of the most helpful are listed here for your convenience.

to select an available setting, or to move the cursor or focus up.

Home to move the cursor to the beginning of the field you are editing.

End to move the cursor to the end of the field you are editing.

Spacebar to toggle an option between enabled and disabled; or to press a button.

Alt+to activate a drop-down list or combination box.

Tab to move the focus to the next control.

Shift+Tab to move the focus to the previous control.

Alt+Tab to switch to another open applications.
Alt+Spacebar to activate the control menu.

Alt+F4 to close an application.
