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1) UnInstaller Mover and UnInstaller 3 Features

Welcome to UnInstaller Mover! UnInstaller Mover is a fully enabled feature of UnInstaller 3. It will move applications from one partition, or drive, to another - safely and easily! Just follow the steps and your applications will have a new home.

UnInstaller 3 is the safest way to clean Windows® 3.x systems. In addition to UnInstaller Mover, UnInstaller 3 gives you three other unique application management tools - **Delete**, **Archive** and **Transport** - to clean up and reorganize your hard drive, safely recapturing lost disk space and restoring operating speed. UnInstaller 3 Features

Delete Safely and completely removes unwanted applications and related files.

Archive Offers you an easy way to compress, store and retrieve infrequently used applications like tax applications or games.

Transport Provides true application portability by allowing you to replicate an application and all related files on a second PC, such as a home computer or laptop.

Windows Cleanup Gives you the ability to rid your system of nineteen of the most common file types that clutter hard drives, including fonts, clip art, Help files, back-up files, drivers and sounds.

Duplicate File Finder Helps you find duplicate files anywhere on your system, selecting from a range of filtering criteria including name, size, date, file type and location. Searches can span multiple disk drives as well.

Orphan Finder Safely and completely removes the remnants of applications manually deleted before using UnInstaller.

A new **tabular interface** that allows you to select your level of expertise. Novice users can have UnInstaller make all the decisions for them, while advanced users can avail themselves of greater levels of detail.

2) Notices

Installation Monitor:

When using the Setup Monitor feature to track an installation, results **may** be less complete if the application already resides in whole or in part on the system. Some installation programs will not overwrite files already found on a system. In this circumstance, files cannot be noted by the monitoring process and may be missed in a de-installation process.

Some applications, upon completion of their installation, require a restart of Windows and/or the system itself. Again, this may have less-than-complete results from UnInstaller's Setup Monitor, particularly if the application's installation process relies on running anything from DOS before the installation completes.
