

## The Systems of Man versus God's Way

Science and the Scientific Method - Attempts to eliminate all but one variable (not representative of reality) and then exhaustively tests that one variable over time when subjected to certain changes (chemical, biological, physical) and reports on the changes in a systematic fashion. The fallacy of the scientific method can be demonstrated by its results: toxic waste dumps, nuclear power plant meltdowns and waste with a half life of many thousands of years, suicide machines, fetal tissue farming so the rich can live longer, ozone depletion from CRC's and the list grows daily. Scientists are the closer than most other people to God's divine creation and yet they are blind and can't see His handiwork. They worship the created and not the Creator. They describe this Universal Creative Power as the forces of Nature and attempt to duplicate them in the laboratory. Using biogenetic engineering and gene splicing techniques they think they can improve on God's creation. Silly, silly man.

Mysticism - The belief that mankind has a tendency to believe there are forces "out there somewhere" beyond our understanding but that he can not explain or prove. In other words, man has a tendency to believe in the "Boogey-man."

Atheism - The belief there is no God.

Agnosticism - The belief there isn't enough evidence to prove or disprove God's existence.

Gnosticism - A religion which claims to have Jesus Christ as it's central figure but is really a skillful blending of many Eastern religions and pseudo Christianity. They have developed their own mythical characters (Aeons, Achamoth and Demiurge) and places (Pleroma).

Hedonism - The religion of 'ME FIRST!' Their belief is 'if it feels good, do it.' Complete self-gratification.

Secular Humanism - The belief that humans are the most important things in the universe and are capable of producing solutions to all of their own problems without any outside assistance (God).

Monotheism - A religion that maintains there is only one god. Christianity and Judaism are examples of monotheism.

Polytheism - A religion that maintains there is more than one god or tolerates worship of more than one god. Early Roman, Greek and Egyptian mythologies are examples of polytheism.

Spartanism - Belief that a hardy lifestyle is best. In Spartanism it's okay to steal just don't get caught. A penalty for stealing was having

your hand cut off.

Asceticism - Life of a hermit, bare walls, sleeping on bare floor and eating and drinking only enough to stay alive. Asceticism is the opposite of materialism and believes happiness is found in nothingness.

Materialism - Belief that owning many earthly possessions will bring happiness.

Monasticism - The withdrawal from the rest of the world into monasteries. The adherents are called monks and take vows of poverty, charity and service to others. A very appealing form of life to strongly religious individuals. Their self-induced suffering appears to heighten the adherent's feeling of closeness to God.

Heurism - Problem-solving approach. Believes that algorithms can be developed for classes of problems. Heuristics also uses rule of thumb approach.

Pragmatism - Takes what they believe is the practical, logical approach to a problem. Common sense approach.

Egotism - Belief in self above all else.

Satanism - Worship of the temporary evil leader of this dark world.

The Occult - Worship demons, devils, witches, wizards, warlocks.

Divination - Using unearthly powers to predict future events.

Black Arts - Use of Satanic or demonic forces to change earthly events.

Magic - Usually involves sleight of hand or illusions, sometimes depends on demonic forces.

Democracy - Rule by majority either directly or representative form of government.

Dictatorship - Rule by one person.

Oligarchy - Rule by a few.

Monarchy - Rule by a king or queen.

Autocracy - Rule by a wealthy ruling class of people.

Socialism - System of sharing wealth between rich and poor workers.

Communism - All property belongs to the state which is supposed to represent everyone.

Other Eastern Religions - Islam - Buddhism - Mohammedanism - Taoism - Shintuism - Confucianism - Moslem religion, Muslims -

Roman Catholicism - Church that was formed by mixing the early church with pagans when Constantine decreed Christianity to be the state religion around 350 A.D. Worst calamity to ever befall the Christian Church.

Protestant Reformation - The Protesters or Protestants like Martin Luther objected to the obscene, evil, demonic and immoral practices then in use by the Roman Catholic clergy and popes including selling of indulgences (certificates of sin signed by the Pope), sale of church offices, use of harlots and consorts, torture and murder for suspected heretics in the name of Jesus Christ.
