<u>Control Information</u> <u>Getting Custom Controls Written</u>

Description

NoBoot allows a program to enable and disable Ctrl-Alt-Del. This is accomplished using VRBTD.386. This VxD must be installed in the [386Enh] section of the SYSTEM.INI file.

At run-time, this controls Enabled property determines whether or not Ctrl-Alt-Del works. When Enabled is True, Ctrl-Alt-Del works. When False, Ctrl-Alt-Del does not work.

Distribution Note When you develop and distribute an application that uses NoBoot, you should install the file NOBOOT1.VBX into the users Windows SYSTEM directory. NoBoot has version information built into it. So, during installation, you should ensure that you are not overwriting a newer version of NoBoot.
