The following are the directions:

Move the VBBar.EXE file into the Visual Basic directory (ie D:\VB). You must also have the Microsoft Visual Basic runtime file "Vbrun100.dll" available on-line everywhere. After that you are ready to start.

What the program does:

To put it simply, VB Bar will provide access to many of Visual Basic's commands on a button bar. I found this to be extremely useful when working on a screen-sized program.

VB Bar will automatically start Visual Basic when run. VB Bar will float on top of the other windows, so it will always remain on top. The buttons are pretty self-explanatory, but just need one clarification. Visual Basic must be the active program when VB Bar is clicked, or the commands will be sent to the wrong program (this shouldn't cause any problems).
