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**Introduction**

Digital will display the Date, Time, Memory usage and Free disk space in a single window or as many different windows as the user requires. The digital windows can be placed anywhere on the screen by simply dragging the window with the left mouse button. The color of the digital window can be changed by placing the mouse pointer over the digital window and clicking the right mouse button with the shift key depressed. This will activate the color selection Dialog Box. The Digital display configuration can be selected from the Configuration Dialog Box which is activated by placing the mouse pointer over the digital window and clicking the right mouse button.

## **Time**

The display has the following formats that can be selected from the Configuration Dialog Box.

- a) 12 Hour  
**9:20pm**
- b) 24 Hour  
**21:20**

## **Date**

The Date display has the following formats that can be selected from the Configuration Dialog Box.

a) Numeric

**Sun 9/9/90**

b) Alpha

**Sun Sept 9,1990**

## Free Memory

The memory display has the following formats which are determined by the memory model you are using.

- a) Real, no EMS
  - r 340k** (amount of 640K remaining)
- b) Real, EMS
  - r 340k/1200k** (memory above the EMS line/free EMS)
- c) Standard
  - s 1024k/11000k** (largest contiguous block/total free)
- e Enhanced
  - e 1024k/11000k** (largest contiguous block/total free)

## **Free Disk Space**

The free disk space can display the free space on the selected disk. The disk is selected in the Configuration Dialog Box. This display has the following format.

**C 12000K**



## **Save Control**

This control puts your selections into effect and also saves them in the digital ini file for future use.

**OK Control**

This control puts your selections into effect when selected.

**Cancel Control**

Your selections will be ignored when this control is selected.

## **Text Group Box**

The Text Group box Select either the foreground or background color of the text for change by the RGB Scroll Bars.

## **RGB Scroll Bars**

Each Scroll Bar controls each of the red, green, or blue values that make the color selection. The selected value is display next to each scroll bar and the resulting text colors are shown above the Text Group Box.

## **Save Control**

This control puts your selections into effect and also saves them in the digital ini file for future use.

**OK Control**

This control puts your selections into effect when selected.

**Cancel Control**

Your selections will be ignored when this control is selected.



## **Close Control**

This control will close the window and exit the digital display. If the window is a Clone only it will be closed. If the window is the top or parent window , it and all its clones will be closed.

## **Clone Control**

The Clone control will start another Digital window that can be configured independent of any other Digital windows. This control is only enabled in the top or parent Digital window

## **UnClone Control**

Unclone removes the cloned window from the clone list and closes the window. This control is only enabled in the clone windows Configuration dialog box.

## **Help Control**

If you are reading this you already know what the Help control does.

## **Format Controls**

Use **Num Date** or **Alpha Date** to select the format of the Date Display. The **12 hr Clock** or **24 hr Clock** will select the Time Display Format.

## **Display Controls**

The Display controls can be selected in any combination and will have the following effects.

- a) If only a single control is selected a single line window will appear with that element in it.
- b) If the date and time are selected they will appear in a single line.
- c) If date and/or time and either memory or disk are selected a two line window appear.
- d) If both memory and disk are selected they will alternate being displayed on a single line.

The selections will not go into effect until the OK or Save control is selected.

## **Drive Control**

Use the Scroll bar to increment or decrement the Drive letter above it. Then select OK or Save as required.

## **Location Control**

The location control is an alternative way of placing the Digital window on the screen. Enter the X and Y location in the edit boxes and the window will appear at that location when the OK or Save Control is selected.
