## **Use Joker**

Here you can cheat a little bit by adding a Joker to the cardset. It acts like the best card you need.

## **Pairs**

With this not highlighted pairs do not count.

## **Animation**

The cardsmovements and the flushing of the buttons can be turned on and off.

## **Soundeffects**

Turn the sounds on and off.

## **Hold**

The programm can highlight usefull combinations or not.

## **Automatic**

The programm plays alone until you turn it off.

## **Sort**

You can choose if the cars are sorted or not.

## **German / English**

Choose your preferred language.

## **New Game**

This starts a new game after a "Are you sure ?"-Box.

## **Help**

Shows the online helpfile.

## **Continue**

Uses and saves the options.

## **Cancel**

You exit the options without any changes.

# List of Bargain

**One pair**

This doubles your bet.

**Two pairs**

Four times your bet.

**Threene**

Six times your bet.

**Street**

A Street is an order of cards in following numbers. The normal Street is without the Ace. Your bet raised 10 times.

**large Street**

A Street with an Ace at the top. Your bet multiplied by 20.

**Flush**

All cards with the same color (Cross, Heart and so on). Your bet by 40 times.

**Full House**

Three of a kind and two of a kind is a Full House. Your bet by 50 times.

**Four of a kind**

You must have four cards of the same kind. Your bet is multiplied by 100.

**Straight Flush**

A Street in one color without an Ace. Your bet by 150 times.

**Royal Flush**

A Street in one color with Ace at the top. Your bet multiplied by 200 times.

# Usage

## **Players**

At first you have to choose how many players will play. Press the related Button and insert the names of the players.

## **Name of player**

This shows the name of the actual player.

## **Bet**

Next you have to choose how many points you would like to use.

## **Hold cards**

You have to choose which cards you want to hold. Press the related buttons and then on START. The unmarked cards now will change to new ones.

## **Risk**

If you get a bargain, this is shown in the BARGAIN-Window. If the bargain is higher than one pair the RISK-Button is highlighted. Now you can choose between RISK to double the bargain or to play on with START.

## **Which Risk**

If you push RISK you can choose between two kind of RISK. HIGH/BLACK presents "higher or lower", RED / LOW presents "red or black". Choose the one you like and push the Button.

## **Higher / Lower**

A card is shown and you have to choose if the next one is higher or lower (Ace is the highest). If you are right the bargain is doubled, if not you loose your bargain completly. If you are right you can play on with START or try your luck again with HIGH or LOW to double your bargain again.

## **Red / Black**

The act is the same like Higher / Lower. You have to choose if the next card shown is red or black.
