The petition for a writ of certiorari is denied. JUSTICE BLACKMUN, dissenting. I am inclined to agree with Judge Kravitch, concurring in part and dissenting in part, 988 F. 2d 1082, 1093 (CA11 1993), and would grant certiorari on the issue whether counsel rendered effective assistance as required by the Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments.
