## CERTIORARI DENIED

The application for stay of execution of sentence of death presented to Justice Scalia and by him referred to the Court is denied.

The petition for a writ of certiorari is denied.

Justice Blackmun dissenting:

Adhering to my view that the death penalty cannot be imposed fairly within the constraints of our Constitution, see my dissent in <u>Callins</u> v.

<u>Collins</u>, 510 U.S. \_\_\_,\_\_ (1994), I would grant certiorari and vacate the death sentence in this case.
