CERTIORARI -- SUMMARY DISPOSITION

94-218 CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, ET AL. V. BRIDGEPORT COALITION FOR FAIR REPRESENTATION, ET AL.

The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted.

The judgments are vacated and the case is remanded to the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit with instructions to vacate the judgments of the United States District Court for the District of Connecticut and then to remand the case to the United States District Court for the District of Connecticut for further consideration in light of Johnson v. De Grandy, ____ U.S. ____ (1994). The Clerk is directed to issue the judgment forthwith. The application for stay presented to Justice Thomas and by him referred to the Court is dismissed as moot.
