Sure-loc Aluminum Edging offers a complete line of Aluminum Landscape Edging products. Sure-loc Aluminum was designed by Engineers, Landscape Architects, and Landscape Contractors. The Sure-loc product development team incorporated the following features into the design.

Features:

1) Positive Joint Locking System.

Benefit: The locking system is designed to securely lock the joining sections of edging together. The positive locking system is held securely by two sturdy Aluminum Stakes. This unique system is very simple to install. The locking system provides one clean, crisp, and continuous line.

2) Fully Ridged and Grooved Design.

Benefit: The ridges and grooves allow the edging to bite into the ground. This keeps the edging down in the ground and minimizes the effects of frost heave.

3) Dual Stake Lancing Points.

Benefit: The two stake lock lancing points insure the stake is driven straight down into the ground. The two lanced points also lock the stake securely to the edging incorporating the stakes and the edging into one system. By having the stakes locked to the edging they cannot be pushed upwards above the top edge of the edging. This avoids the problem of stakes sticking out of the ground.

4) Stakes Points Located 1 Inch Below The Top Edge.

Benefit: There are no visible stakes - this provides a clean look. The stakes are also out of the way so maintenance equipment won't catch on them.

5) Sturdy Extruded Aluminum Stakes.

Benefit: The stakes are 1.5" wide by 11.5" long with an optional 1.5" x 18" stake available. The heavy duty extruded aluminum stakes are not easily bent during the installation process.

6) Flush Inside Unobstructed Edge.

Benefit: The stakes are all secured to the same side of the edging. This allows for a consistently smooth inside edge when using as a paver brick restraint.

7) End Stake Adaptors.

Benefit: The End Stake Adaptor allows for versatility in staking the edging at all the critical start and stop points. The End Stake Adaptor also allows the contractor to install additional stakes at any point they deem necessary. The End Stake Adaptor can also be used to splice two cut pieces together - this eliminates having

to scrap a section if the locking system has been cut off.

8) Flexibility of Aluminum.

Benefit: The use of aluminum allows for creative design possibilities. The aluminum can easily form almost every curvilinear application that can be imagined. The properties of aluminum allow for ease at virtually any temperature. Aluminum does not rust like Steel and have the high labor cost associated with installing steel edging. Aluminum does become brittle with age, or easily damage with maintenance equipment like a plastic product does. Aluminum will not rot like wood and is far easier to install especially if curves are in the design.

9) Low Product Cost.

Benefit: Sure-loc Aluminum Edging is sold factory direct to the Landscape Contractor. There are no middle man mark-ups from your quoted pricing. This will save upwards of 40% on product cost. Product Applications:

1/8" x 4" (3.2mm x 102mm) - Used primarily for residential or light commercial applications. Used as a planting bed edging, and as a paver restraint for patios or walkways.

3/16" x 4" (4.8mm x 102mm) - Used primarily for commercial, industrial, and institutional facilities. Used for edging of planting beds, a paver restraint, walking trails, running tracks, asphalt borders, and for maintenance strips. Works well for both long straight runs and curves.

1/8" x 5.5" (3.2mm x 140mm) - Used primarily for residential or light commercial applications where the planting bed may need the additional depth for separation. Works especially well for containing grasses with deep roots that wander.

3/16" x 5.5" (4.8mm x 140mm) - Used primarily for commercial, industrial, and institutional facilities where maximum depth and strength of a heavy duty product is needed. Excellent for long straight runs. This product is extremely durable and can be used in heavy traffic areas. The use of this heavy duty product still allows for easily formed curves.

Sure-loc Aluminum is available in a variety of finishes and can be special ordered in almost any color or finish. If you choose to use a colored finish we strongly recommend using an anodized versus a painted finish, the anodized finish offers far greater durability.
