BROCK DOCK and the various pier and dock components offered with it make the ideal solution for dock builders and owners of residential and commercial properties. The deck planks are made with a Hi-Polymer grade PVC. The planks cut like wood but last years longer, perform better, and reduce the high cost of maintenance associated with traditional dock materials.

The high-quality vinyl compound making up BROCK DOCK is similar to that used by vinyl siding and window manufacturers. It is specially-formulated for outdoor exposure where color and physical property retention are important. Our vinyl compound contains 20% to 25% more ultraviolet inhibitors than most vinyl siding products in order to shield BROCK DOCK from the sun's harmful rays. Impact modifiers give added strength and impact resistance in all weather conditions, while preventing denting or splitting. The formula also gives BROCK DOCK the ability to resist blistering, flaking, corroding, or peeling.

BROCK DOCK's planks can be secured to wood, concrete, galvanized steel, or aluminum structures. There are no surface nails or screws, splinters or slivers to cause personal injury. Extensive testing has proven this material to be ideally suited for docks, walkways, and decks. Once you try it, *you'll never go back to wood!*

Because the planking cuts like wood, many custom designs can be achieved. The three colors available for the BROCK DOCK planking can help complement any architectural style.

INSTALLATION

Installing a dock is easy using BROCK DOCK. BROCK DOCK is attached to the support stringers using the special CLIP-STRIP® furnished by CTB Vinyl Products. Builders and installers like the CLIP-STRIP System. It is quick to install with a minimum number of screws and attaches dock planks firmly to any type of dock substructure (wood, aluminum, galvanized steel, or concrete). Planks are attached with the use of a dead blow hammer. A variety of trim options are available to finish exposed plank ends.

Other dock and pier components also available from CTB Vinyl Products include encapsulated wood stringers, galvanized steel pipe supports, vinyl post covers, and vinyl edge guards to protect both boat and dock.

TESTING

BROCK DOCK is manufactured by CTB Vinyl Products under strict quality control procedures. Every hour, 24 hours a day, samples are pulled off the extrusion line and checked for wall thickness, impact strength and eight other criteria. This constant testing during manufacturing guarantees BROCK DOCK durability, beauty and safety.

The “raw” polyvinylchloride we use for our Hi-Polymer mix is of the highest quality. Every batch is laboratory-tested and certified to assure that it meets our demanding standards.
