Finished upon our recommendations, your floors will require little or_no maintenance. Your floors can be cleaned with any household cleaner (e.g., Murphy's Oil Soap) and require no waxing. Our recommended finish is a tung oil which can be spot applied in highly worn areas, facilitating long term care. When it becomes necessary to refinish the entire floor, you do not need to sand off the existing finish; you need only apply another coat of tung oil.
