Agreement

Disk Piecharter is a "shareware program" and is provided at no charge to the user for evaluation. Feel free to share it with your friends, but please do not give it away altered or as part of another system. The essence of "user-supported" software is to provide personal computer users with quality software without high prices, and yet to provide incentive for programmers to continue to develop new products. If you find this program useful and find that you are using Disk Piecharter and continue to use Disk Piecharter after a reasonable trial period, you must make a registration payment of \$ 15. to <u>ZORN SOFTWARE</u>. The \$ 15. registration fee will license one copy for use on any one computer at any one time. You must treat this software just like a book. DEFINITION OF SHAREWARE

Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are expected to register. Individual programs differ on details -- some request registration while others require it, some specify a maximum trial period. With registration, you get anything from the simple right to continue using the software to an updated program with printed manual.

Copyright laws apply to both Shareware and commercial software, and the copyright holder retains all rights, with a few specific exceptions as stated below. Shareware authors are accomplished programmers, just like commercial authors, and the programs are of comparable quality. (In both cases, there are good programs and bad ones!) The main difference is in the method of distribution. The author specifically grants the right to copy and distribute the software, either to all and sundry or to a specific group. For example, some authors require written permission before a commercial disk vendor may copy their Shareware.

Shareware is a distribution method, not a type of software. You should find software that suits your needs and pocketbook, whether it's commercial or Shareware. The Shareware system makes fitting your needs easier, because you can try before you buy.

And because the overhead is low, prices are low also. Shareware has the ultimate money-back guarantee -- if you don't use the product, you don't pay for it.

How to enter your keystring

Filling in this form only makes sense if you have registered this product (that is, paid \$ 15) and received your personal keystring from <u>Zorn Software</u>.

If that is the case, then you have to fill in the key EXACTLY as you received it. If you received it via E-mail, the easiest way is to copy the string to the clipboard and then pasting it into the field on the dialog (by using the Paste Clipboard button or by pressing SHIFT/Insert or ctrl-V).

Filesizes

- On compressed disks, the logical (uncompressed) filesizes are shown.
- Filesizes are always expressed in terms of disk allocation. This means it shows the allocated space for files, which depends on the clustersize of your disk drive. Thus, you get a more accurate impression of disk usage, especially with (larger numbers of) small files.

Using Disk Piecharter for Windows 95

- 1 In the combobox at the top left, select a disk drive. Disk Piecharter starts gathering directory information; this may take some time. In the left bottom of the window you can see the directories it is reading.
- 2 In the left pane you will see the tree structure, in a format similar to the Explorer. This tree structure, however, only shows directories. Sorting order is by the size of the directory contents.
- 3 The right pane shows the piechart. Note that the piechart has only four colours: green for free space, yellow for directories and light blue for files. Plus grey (not always visible) for system space used by directories.
- 4 Click the left mousebutton inside one of the yellow (directory) segments of the pie to zoom in on that directory (mousecursor is a magnifying glass with a '+').
- 5 Click with the left mousebutton within the window (but outside the pie) to zoom out (mousecursor is a magnifying glass with a '-').
- 6 Click with the right mousebutton in a directory or a file segment if you want to delete it (a confirmation box will appear). This function can be disabled with the 'Enable delete' option on the <u>Preferences</u> dialog. For safety it will be disabled by default on installation. Note that deleted files are NOT going to the recycle-bin.
- 7 Alternatively, you can navigate through the directory structure using the treeview on the left. Click on a directory name to 'zoom in'. Note that the tree of that directory automatically expands. This feature can be disabled in the <u>Preferences</u> dialog. Also, when selecting a directory within a different branch of the tree, the previous tree will automatically collapse. Again, this feature can be disabled in the <u>Preferences</u> dialog.
- 8 Use menu option 'Refresh' or F5 to refresh the contents of the piechart if the diskcontents have changed. No automatic update occurs, so this is the only way to keep the physical disk and piechart diagram up-to-date with each other.
- 9 Use menu option File/Copy to make a metafile-type ('picture') copy of the piechart to the clipboard. As this is an Enhanced Metafile, the geometry depends on the size and shape of your Disk Piecharter window on the screen (I don't know why they call this behaviour 'enhanced').

Preferences

Auto expand

This checkbox controls whether the auto-expand function in the treeview pane is active or not. Auto expand means the directory tree will automatically expand one level when you select it, either by clicking on it in the tree window or on the corresponding pie segement.

Auto collapse

This checkbox controls whether the auto-collapse function in the treeview pane is active or not. Auto collapse means an expanded tree will collapse automatically as soon as another branch is selected.

Show Files

Determine whether you want to display individual files, or display all files in a given directory as one pie segment. Displaying individual files slows down Disk Piecharter, and also increases memory usage.

Enable Delete

With this option you can disable the deleting function of Disk Piecharter. Note that deleting files is only possible when the Show Files option is enabled as well.

If this option is selected, an exclamation sign appears next to the mousecursor as soon as this moves over a 'deleteable' area.

 WARNING: Disk Piecharter erases files regardless of read-only and/or hidden status. Also, files are NOT moved to the recycle-bin!

OK-button

Choices are activated as soon as you click this button.
