LEARNING TO SEE THE AURA:

Knowledge of some basic personal information about someone can help you determine what appearance a person's aura is most likely to have, so you can begin to know what to look for. In a full-length reading, we use the name at birth and the birthdate. The aura which can be discovered using full birth name and birthdate is known as the "Natural Aura". However, complete information is not always available, particularly when studying in a casual or public setting. Using just the present name with the day and month of birth can lead to discovery of the "Current Aura". If the name is known, but not the birthday, this information is still helpful in detecting the vibrations that surround a person.

Since the computer screen cannot accurately reproduce the aura as seen by observers, this program simply provides an impressionistic representation to give you a foundation on which to build. Different computer screens represent colors differently. What looks pink on one machine may appear to be blue on another, and so on. Consult the color chart for assistance in interpreting your system's representation of the various colors.

Most experts describe the aura as generally oval in shape. The size of the aura seems to increase with the person's energy. As a person develops spiritual awareness, the aura seems to grow.

The "Chakra Points" are psychic intensity points in the aura, and are sometimes used by healers.

In our computer representation, we have shown the four colors of the chakra patterns of squares or letters. The Chakra Points are represented by stars or asterisks placed in a vertical band at the center of the screen. The first Chakra Point is at the bottom of the screen, indicating the base of the spine, and the points extend upward from there. If extra points have been placed at the very top, they indicate additional significant points in the aura.

The Life Path color was derived from the birthdate, 07/14/1947.

Life Path Color = INDIGO = 6

The Expression color was derived from all the letters in the name. When looking for a Natural Aura, we use the full name at birth.

Expression Color = INDIGO = 6

The Soul Urge color comes from the value of all the vowels in the name

Soul Urge Color = BLUE = 5

The day of birth is the 14th, which has a numerological value of 5.

Birthday Color = BLUE = 5

DETAILS OF THE AURA:

The Life Path color represents the person's purpose in life.

RESPONSIBILITY is the key word for indigo. People who have a lot of this in their aura are generally family-oriented and very good at handling responsibilities. They are reliable and hard hard working, often doing more than they are asked. Love, kind and sympathetic, they also have an appreciation of artistic matters and may be very creative. Although this seems to contradict the blue influence in the aura, inner conflicts are unusual, and are worked out through karmic lessons as indicated by the Points.

This color echoes the expression color and thus intensifies its effect

The Expression color represents the person's natural abilities.

Indigo's key word is RESPONSIBILITY. This is a caring, humanitarian color. People with this color are involved with home and family, as well as other responsibilities. They often take on more than their fair share, but do this willingly. They are loving, appreciative, sympathetic and kind. These people may also be very creative, and they appreciate quality. Although this seems to contradict the blue influence in the aura, inner conflicts are unusual, and are worked out through karmic lessons as indicated by the Points.

Because this is also the Life Path color, the effects are greatly intensified

The Soul Urge color represents the person's inner nature and preferences

FREEDOM is the key word for blue. People whose auras contain a lot of this generally hate to be restricted in any way. Although they may sometimes be a bit immature and rebellious, they are naturally talented in many areas and are good at dealing with the unexpected. Such people seek out change and usually travel a great deal.

This color also appears as the birthday color, so its meaning is even more significant.

The Birthday color acts as a general influence on the person's life.

Blue's key word is FREEDOM. This is the color that never quite grows up and represents variety, and expecting the unexpected. Travel is important to someone with a blue aura, as blue represents blue seas and skies. People with this color hate to be restricted or confined. They are naturally versatile people and are good at everything they attempt, but their love of change and variety makes it hard for them to stay still for very long. They are always looking ahead, never being satisfied for long.

This color is repeated as the Soul Urge color, and thus its effects are emphasized.

THE CHAKRA POINTS:

The first Chakra is known as the root or base Chakra, and it is at the base of the spine. Its color is red, which gives courage and inner strength. Leadership and independence are its associated qualities. The small amount of red in your aura indicates that this area needs work. A weak Chakra point indicates subdued energy in the area.

The second Chakra, in the lower back, relates to your adaptability, consideration, and helpfulness to others. When the energy here is strong, it helps the development of psychic abilities and intuition. A low or average amount of orange in the aura may mean these qualities are not foremost in your consciousness at this time.

The third Chakra is in the solar plexus area. It is yellow, the color of self-expression, happiness, curiosity, and the enjoyment of life. You may find some yellow in your aura, which indicates that these characteristics are in your outward expression.

The fourth Chakra point is between the shoulder blades. This is green, the color of practicality. The energy generated at this point is used for work, attention to detail, organization, and thoroughness. This high concentration of energy at this point could indicate that you need to be careful that this is not an area of obsession or difficulty.

The fifth Chakra point, in the throat area, is blue. The energy here is directed toward versatility and the love of freedom and change. You will probably find that you have a tremendous amount of energy focused on these characteristics in your life.

The sixth Chakra point, sometimes called the "Brow Chakra", is at the forehead. This energy source generates an indigo color, which indicates responsibility, domesticity, care for others, and family values. This point is probably a bit stronger than average. A large amount of indigo in your name indicates high energy in this area.

The seventh Chakra, at the top of the head, is violet, a spiritual color that shows the energy directed to philosophical thinking, logic, metaphysical inner development. The stronger it is, the more likely you are to have useful and unusual viewpoints. The lack of violet in your aura indicates weakness at this Chakra point. In general, missing colors point to qualities you need to develop.

The crown point just above your head in the aura is not a Chakra point. This energy field relates to your compassionate ideals. The energy at this point is about average. This suggests that you have developed these qualities to your best advantage.
