

Mozart development diary

This is a brief catalogue of improvements to MOZART as they are done, starting at release candidate 1.0.0.

Version 1.0.0

October 1994

This version was created with a view to Shareware release. Creating sample tunes involved doing things differently from what I normally do. In addition in this process, I tested various seldom-used features. This turned up a whole lot of nasty bugs - some fatal. Fixed these for version 1.0.1

The GoToBar command (Ctrl G) was failing intermittently. (Thanks to Rodney Young for exposing this.) Have fixed this and have improved the interface so that you can now just press Ctrl+G and then type the bar number and Enter, without looking at the dialogue box on the screen or using the mouse.

Version 1.0.1

October 1994

Registration form button introduced on the registration benefits dialogue for the evaluation version.

Provisional installation program written to accompany release. Uses O'Setup. Results are pleasing - have sent off registration fee.

Further tested before release. Minor oddity discovered in appearance of splash panel when MOZART is run iconised (eg when dragging .mz files from the file manager to the print manager) - and eliminated.

Altered MOZART to run with ctl3dv2.dll instead of ctl3d.dll. This is a better idea now that there is an installation program to check versions.

Added a help button to the box which asks if you want to reformat the music page to agree with the printer page. (This was some work but if a new user installs MOZART and the supplied tunes and tries to open one, then the first thing he will see is that his printer is different from mine. It's only fair to help him answer the question!) The cancel button on this box now works properly - how did I overlook that before?

Trapped error when finding an old version of BWCC - now exits gracefully with message box instead of GPFing. (Why do so many programs leave BWCC all over the place?)
