

# Assassin Help

**Program:** Assassin

**Synopsis:** Assassin terminates a specified application program and optionally will execute a new application. Used in situations where a resource is used by two programs like swapping between a FAX program and a **TERMINAL** program using the same comm port.

**Usage**       : ASSASSIN [/F:File\_Name] [/M:module\_name] [/Help] [/R] [/X:Command]

## Command Line options:

**/f:File\_name**       This option specifies that the running application with the file name **File\_name** is to be terminated. The **/f** option should not be used with the **/m** option.

**/m:Module\_name**       This option specifies that the running application with the module name **Module\_name** is to be terminated. The **/m** option should not be used with the **/f** option.

**/x:Command**       This option specifies a program to execute along with command line parameters (see example). This option must be the last option in the options list.

**/r**       This option specifies that upon termination of the **/x:Command**, the application terminated by either a **/f** or **/m** option will be reexecuted.

**/h or /?**       Either of these options will display the **About** box.

## Example :

**ASSASSIN /f:fax.exe /r /x:terminal**

In this example, the currently running program **fax** will be terminated, then the application **terminal** will be executed. Finally, when **terminal** quits, **fax** will be reexecuted.
