

Dr. Watson's Apprentice v1.0 - What lies ahead?

The first feature I would like to add to Dr. Watson's Apprentice v1.0 is MultiMedia support. The sound files, (MS Windows .WAV), were created with a Sound Blaster Pro in MS Windows 3.1 and played through the internal PC speaker with a generic sound.dll. I am currently experimenting with adding sound card support and allowing the user to add sound to any or all events to reduce the visual need. I would like to add the ability to archive the log files. I would like to hear your comments on this or any other ideas you have that would further develop Dr. Watson's Apprentice v1.0 to an all purpose Windows utility.



Opening the Dr. Watson Log...



When you click on **Open Log**, a ribbon button will appear for each section created for the current log entry open. Click on the ribbon button to view the appropriate information. If there is no information for the current log entry, the appropriate ribbon button will not appear. Note: When you click on **Open Log**, the caption and icon will change to let you know that the next click on that button will close the Dr. Watson Log file.

Printing the Dr. Watson Log...



When you click on *Print*, the pictured dialog box will appear. Notice that for each section of the log entry, there is a corresponding check box. As with the ribbon buttons, if there is no information for one of the sections of the log, the corresponding check box will not appear.

Configuring Dr. Watson's Apprentice v1.0...
