## Problem:

Printer fonts are not displaying correctly on the document screen. For example, if you select the HP Laserjet Series II printer and then select a Line Printer 16.67cpi font in WordPerfect For Windows 5.1, the lettering on the edit screen is identical in size to the Courier 10cpi font.

## Answer:

WP Windows uses Windows screen fonts to show a font on a document screen. If a screen font is not available for the font being used, it won't display as that font on the screen, and a substitute screen font will be used. This deals with size as well. If you ask for a 100pt CG Times font, and a screen font is not available for that size, the 100pt character will not display. What displays on the screen is what is available.
