Installation

I'll describe the installation process in three steps:

- 1: copy program files
- 2: Installing "Sky" in the windows 3.x Program Manager
- 3: Configuring "Sky" for your location

First, copy the program files for "Sky".

To do this from DOS place the installation disk in A: or B:
and type:

```
<DRIVE>:INSTALL<ENTER>
```

now, answer the questions and the files will be
uncompressed onto your hard disk.

If you downloaded this from a BBS then from DOS type:

```
CD \<ENTER>
```

```
MD SKYW<ENTER>
```

```
CD SKYW<ENTER>
```

```
PKUNZIP source-path \SKYW111R.ZIP<ENTER>
```

Next, from window's "Program Manager", select **F**ile then **N**ew.

In the Filename Box type:

```
\SKYW\SKY.EXE
```

Then press **O**k.

Finally, select the icon for "SKY" and run it. Once "SKY" is running select **L**ocal then **L**ocation and scan through the list box for a city near your location (if you can't find one you'll have to find your location on a map and enter it into the Latitude, Longitude, and Time Zone boxes.) Once these are set select Display then **S**ave **D**efaults. "Sky" is installed.
