INTRODUCTION

Islander: Hordes of natives are coming out to attack you (or at least get past you). Shoot them down as they ballon by you before they shoot you down. The more of them that get past you... well it makes your existance more difficult, as you will see.

Car Race: You must use your knowledge of math, english and quick reflexes to succeed in this game. You must complete the obstacles quickly before nightfall.

LOADING THE GAME

This game loads directly from the M-DOS command line. If you have a Memex card with Genmod you may need to set your turbo switch OFF to achieve a reasonable playing speed. You may also need to set TIMODE ON in your AUTOEXEC file. If the game plays too fast, this is an indication that one of these items needs to be adjusted.

Islander: To load, simply enter the name ISLE1 from whatever drive the game disk resides in. For example, if the game disk resides in drive B: enter B:ISLE1

Car Race: To load, simply enter the name CAR1 from whatever drive the game disk resides in. For example, if the game disk resides in drive B: enter B:CAR1

HOW TO START

Islander: Press 1 or 2 on the keyboard to set the number of players. Player 1 will be assigned to joystick 1, player 2 will be assigned to joystick 2. Press A (Amateur) or P (Pro) on the keyboard to set the skill level.

Car Race: Press 1, 2 or 3 to set the skill level.

PLAYING INSTRUCTIONS

Islander: The joystick controls your player. Use the fire button to shoot arrows at the natives as they ballon past you. The effect of allowing invaders to pass you varies with each level... shoot carefully!

Car Race: Answer questions as they are asked. If you need help, read the prompts on the screen to find out how to get clues or answers. Remember, clues cost you points! But then again, so does taking too much time!

TO PLAY AGAIN or QUIT

When the game is over you can press Enter to restart. To reset the game to the beginning, press CTRL-SHIFT-SHIFT at any time. To exit back to M-DOS, press ALT-CTRL-DEL at any time.
