Assorted Commands

Seeker supports several protocols that aren't associated with search engines. There's a seemingly unlimited potential here, but here is what we have so far.

`find`: - Uses Yahoo, mimicking Microsoft Internet Explorer's "find" command.

`hello`: - This command displays a simple hello message.

`open`: - This command allows you to use the Navigator Location bar to open files and folders on local disks. Capitalization of entered text isn't important.

`restart`: - When entered, the "`restart`:" protocol restarts the machine.

`seeker`: - This command visits the Seeker home page at <http://antioch-college.edu/~stefan/seeker.html>.

`shutdown`: - Shuts down the machine.

`stefan`: - Addresses an email message to <mailto:stefan@antioch-college.edu>
