- To get started with Who's There?, simply run it on any Mac OS X machine (10.3 or later) on which you have installed our DoorStop X Firewall, the Norton Personal Firewall or any firewall that logs to the system log via ipfw (such as Mac OS X Server).
- Who's There? 2.0 is a major component of a new, comprehensive suite of products: the DoorStop X Security Suite. It can be purchased individually or as part of that Suite.
- The Who's There? User's Guide is available by opening the file WTUsersGuide.html from any Web browser, or through the Who's There? Help menu.
- If you are using the free evaluation version of Who's There? Firewall Advisor, it will expire thirty days after it is first run. You can purchase a serial number for the product through the Purchase button that it displays when you run it, or off our Web site.
- If you are upgrading, Who's There? 2.0 requires a new serial number, which can be purchased from us at a discounted price.
- Tiger (Mac OS X 10.4) includes limited logging with its "built-in" firewall, and Who's There? supports that logging. However see the warning in the Who's There? User's Guide regarding serious limitations with Tiger's firewall logging.
- If you do not have a firewall installed yet, you can still try out Who's There? by selecting the file "Sample Firewall Log" when asked to locate your firewall's log file. Be sure to then set the view to "ALL dates and times" using the upper left hand popup menu.
- Changes since Who's There? 1.5 include:
- new, modernized look and feel
- integration with the DoorStop X Firewall and our book "Internet Security for Your Macintosh"
- new, optionally-displayed log fields, including source port and destination address
- new Preferences options, including the ability to not display duplicate lines
- new and updated service definitions
- bug fixes
