Installation

1. Quit Netflix Freak if you're an existing user of the program
2. Drag the Netflix Freak icon from the Netflix Freak volume to your Applications folder
3. You can then discard the Netflix Freak volume and the netflixfreak.dmg file

1. A Netflix account
2. Any Macintosh that is running Mac OS X, version 10.2.6 or later

Purchasing and registering this product

This product is shareware (\$15). For 30 days, you can use a full version of the product for free. To purchase the product during the trial period, go to the **Netflix Freak** menu in the menu bar and choose the **Registration...** menu item.

Registration numbers are automatically generated by the purchase process and automatically entered into the program, so you don't need to enter them manually. As soon as the purchase is approved, the program will be unlocked immediately. You will receive a registration number via email should you need to move Netflix Freak to a new system. To re-enter a registration number, go to the **Netflix Freak** menu in the menu bar and choose the **Registration...** menu item.

Caveats

This program is designed to interface directly with the Netflix website and to adapt should Netflix change the format of their website. However, it's conceivable that at some point in the future, a change in the Netflix website could cause this program to no longer function properly. Because of this possibility, we're offering a 30 day money-back guarantee when purchasing this product, no questions asked.

License

The license for this product allows the purchaser to use this product on any machine to connect to their Netflix account. It is not restricted to one machine.
