STUDENT USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES

The principal of each building shall make regulations concerning the riding of bicycles and the driving/parking of motor vehicles on school premises. **{NOTE: I revised the previous statement by replacing "to and from school" with "on school premises". I also added a reference to parking. School districts may not have authority to regulate students driving to or from school. In general, school officials may only have authority to regulate student conduct on school grounds (e.g., parking on school grounds), during the school day (e.g., leaving school grounds during school hours) or while participating in school-related activities.}** Students will be expected to learn and observe the established regulations.

No student shall be authorized to drive any school vehicle unless enrolled in the driving phase of the driver education course.
