JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

The technology director shall:

- 1. Be an active member of the technology committee.
- 2. Attempt to solve problems before they arise by keeping printers, computers, monitors, and keyboards free from dust, grime and foreign objects.
- 3. Arrange printers, scanners, copiers and other peripherals so that they are accessible for maintenance.
- 4. Monitor all classroom labs to prevent maintenance problems.
- 5. Maintain and operate local area networks (LANs).
- 6. Maintain and monitor security for LANs.
- 7. Install and configure network applications/software.
- 8. Keep a maintenance log on each piece of equipment.
- 9. Provide staff training that includes such topics as using computers in the classroom, selecting software and integrating software into the curriculum.
- 10. Work with the administration to prepare adequate budget for technology.

- Train two-three staff at each building to provide basic repair services (e.g., fix printers, change printer ribbons).
- 12. Make judgments on which repairs need immediate attention.
- 13. Repair technologies a expeditiously as possible.
- 14. Perform other duties as may be assigned. {NOTE: I added this item to provide flexibility.}
