Welcome to FishTank! This simple application allows you to perform some "what-if" calculations about that new aquarium you've been wanting. It's a 32-bit application for Windows 95/NT. If you're using Windows NT, you need at least version 3.51.

FishTank is basically a aquarium size calculator. You enter size data for the aquarium and the water type, and the program computes various information about the prospective aquarium.

FishTank is freeware. Feel free to distribute it anywhere, as long as it is transmitted in its original archive file FISHTANK.ZIP with all associated files unmodified and included. You may not sell or distribute FishTank for profit without first obtaining permission from the author. This program and its associated files are provided as-is, and the author accepts no liability for damages incurred by the user from the use of this software.

To install:

Create a directory somewhere and copy all of the files in the FISHTANK.ZIP file to it. From there you can double click on the FISHTANK.EXE file or create a shortcut to it.

To uninstall:

Delete the directory where you unzipped the FISHTANK.ZIP file.

Once FishTank is installed, you should be able to access the Help file. Please read it for detailed instructions.
