What It Does

ArcTime allows you to select those files which were modified during a given time period. For example, suppose you want to back up just the files that you worked on today. ArcTime starts up with the date range set for today. Clicking on the Select Files button will list all the files in the chosen directory that have modification times between midnight and now. You then choose a directory to copy the files to, click on the Copy button and you're done. You can adjust the time period to include to whatever date & time range you might need.

If you pay bills online, develop software, write school papers, anything that changes some files in a directory, but not necessarily all of them, then ArcTime will help you save just the work you need to -- quickly and easily.

Entering Dates

There are three different ways to enter date values into the 'To' and 'From' fields. Most simply you can type in a date in mm/dd/yy format. Or, tapping either the '+' or '-' keys while one of the date fields is highlighted will increment or decrement respectively the date value in one day intervals. Finally, double clicking on the date field brings up a dialog box which allows you to select a date from a graphic calendar.

Getting File Information

You can view the last modification time and size of a file by highlighting the file name in the Selected Files list. The information will then be displayed in the text window below the list.

Deselecting A File

Highlighting a file name in the File Selected box and pressing the Delete key will remove the file from the list and keep it from being copied.

Entering Times

Times can be entered into the To and From boxes manually and adjusted in one hour increments by hitting the '+' and '-' keys.

Overwriting Files

Existing files will not be overwritten without your permission. If a file with the same name already exists in the target directory, you will be presented with a dialog box warning you of the conflict. Then you are allowed to cancel or proceed with the operation.

License

You are entitled to use this software un-registered for evaluation purposes only, for a period of 15 days from the date of installation. At the end of this trial period, you must either purchase a license to use this product (see <u>Registration</u>), or you must remove the software and its associated files from the computer it is installed on.

There may be an expiration date built into the software which will disable some or all of the functionality of the product prior to the end of that 15-day trial period.
