Adding Programs

To add programs to QuickClick, drag any icon from your desktop or Explorer to the area to the right of the default icon and drop. Or press the button to the right of text box to select through a dialog box.

Removing Programs

To remove programs from QuickClick, right click on the icon and click yes.

Running Programs

To run a program, click the icon of the program on the taskbar tray or if you have "Show QuickClick Programs in Menu" checked, you can right click on the taskbar icon, you selected in Quick Configurations, and select the program from the menu. The caption of the program can be modified by typing the change into the text box. The tooltip on the taskbar will be the caption. You can run 8 programs will one click by placing programs in the Autorun tab.

Terminating Programs

To end a program, right click on the corresponding icon on the taskbar. If you want to end all programs activated through QuickClick by way of the taskbar or by AutoRun, right click on the Taskbar Icon and click "Close All QuickClick Programs". This will end all 8 AutoRun programs and all 20 QuickClick programs. If you only want to end the 8 programs activated through AutoRun, right click the same icon and click "Close All AutoRun Programs".

The Explorer cannot be closed this way. Your desktop is tied to the explorer. Also, you cannot end your dial up connection this way either.

Known Limitations

Types of files that QuickClick will run:

Any EXE, COM, BAT, HLP, TXT, DOC, RTF, MDB, XLS file and ShortCuts.
