Introduction

This software provides a *fast* and *free* viewing capability for JPEG image files under the Microsoft Windows® environment.

Features

- It's Free (no guilt)!
- Support is provided for 256 shade gray scale, 256 quantized colors, and 24-bit color.
- It will save images into Windows Bitmap files (BMP).
- It supports exporting of the uncompressed image to the clipboard.
- It comes with on-line help.

Limitations

- It doesn't save or write any other file formats.
- It doesn't create JPEG files, it only displays them.

Installation

Windows 3.0

1. Create a new directory on the hard disk.
2. Copy the `jview.exe` or `jview386.exe`, and `jview.hlp` to the new directory.
3. Copy the `commdlg.dll` file to the `\windows\system` directory.
4. Install the `jview.exe` program as describe on page 88 of the Microsoft Windows' User's Guide - Adding Program Items and Documents to a Group.

Windows 3.1

1. Create a new directory on the hard disk.
2. Copy the `jview.exe` or `jview386.exe`, and `jview.hlp` to the new directory.
3. Install the `jview.exe` program as describe on page 78 of the Microsoft Windows' User's Guide - Creating a Program Item.
