This is the common dialog macro from Gordon McComb.

Note that you must move the file called WORDDLG.DLL into your Windows directory before trying this beast.

This is the original version for WPWin; a newer version I have in a DLL that's not fully tested works a little differently, and with WinWord as well as VB (since I have to use my DLL anyway, not using the Common Dialog custom control that comes with VB 2.0 just saves me a file). The newer version allows you to set the file types (it's hard coded in this version).
