


Made for Shade

Bright Ideas

Follow these tips to design dazzling containers for shade.

SELECT SHADE DWELLERS

Choose plant varieties recommended for shade or part-sun. Check labels for light requirements. Sun-loving plants produce few, if any, blooms in the shade.


KEEP COMBOS SIMPLE

Pick three to five plant varieties for each design. For large pots, proportionately increase the number of each variety.
