flutterby petite lavender butterfly bush

Flutterby Petite Lavender butterfly bush gives you lots and lots of fragrant **flowers** (from summer to fall) on a compact plant that's perfect for the front of the border, window boxes, and hanging baskets. Like its common name suggests, it attracts lots of butterflies! According to the breeder, because it's virtually sterile, you can grow it in areas where other varieties are considered invasive.

Name: Flutterby Petite Blue Heaven *Buddleja* 'Podaras #12'

Growing conditions: Full sun and well-drained **soil**

Size: To 30 inches tall and wide

Zones: 5-9
