Go to BHG.com/ springcontainers for more containers suitable for cool weather. These annuals revel in chilly spring weather and even handle a bit of frost (exceptions noted). Garden centers usually stock them weeks before your last frost. Go ahead and plant them in pots or flowerbeds long before their heat-loving cousins.



Lettuce

SIZE: Up to 6 inches

COLOR: Green- and purple-leaf varieties. Often sold as mixes.

USES: Easy to grow in pots or beds, alone or to create nice contrast with other plants. Be sure to grow enough to harvest and eat!



Lobelia

SIZE: Up to 6 inches

COLOR: Known for intense blue blooms, it also comes in white, rose, and purple. (Shown: 'Blue Star')

USES: Trailing habit is great for baskets. It likes cool temps but won't take frost.



Viola

SIZE: 4-8 inches

COLOR: Blooms in many hues, often in bi- or tricolors. (Shown: 'Sorbet Purple Duet')

USES: Equally at home in pots and beds. Very hardy—fall plantings will rebloom the following spring.



Osteospermum

SIZE: 12-18 inches

COLOR: Daisy flowers in yellow, white, purple, or pink. (Shown: '3D Purple')

USES: Great container plant. Takes summer heat as well as frost, but may cease blooming in hot summer weather.



Sweet alyssum

SIZE: 4-8 inches

COLOR: White, pink, red, or violet blooms are highly fragrant. (Shown: 'Easter Bonnet White')

USES: The spreading, trailing habit is good for containers or edging.



Diascia

SIZE: 15-18 inches

COLOR: Airy, white to pink blooms (Shown: 'Diamonte Coral Rose')

USES: Primarily used as a container plant. Tolerates heat, but needs some protection from direct sun in the summer.



Stock

SIZE: 12-30 inches

COLOR: White, pink, or purple blooms. (Shown: 'Sugar and Spice Violet')

USES: Containers or beds. The strong, sweet fragrance adds romance to gardens.



Nemesia

SIZE: 12-16 inches

COLOR: White, pink, orange, red, or lavender blooms. (Shown: 'Opal Innocence')

USES: Best in pots. Blooms in spring, again in autumn, but may cease in summer.
