There are lots of New Guinea **impatiens** on the market, but the Magnum series stands out because of its huge **flowers**. 'Magnum Lavender' offers a strong, upright habit and dark green foliage with lavender-pink flowers that can reach 3 inches across.

Name: *Impatiens* 'Magnum Lavender'

Growing conditions: Full sun or part shade and moist, well-drained **soil**

Size: To 12 inches tall and wide

Grow it with: Wax begonias, which are great for a smaller accent
