Pansies and Violas

Plant this living arrangement for a party, and then move the plants outdoors to enjoy for months to come.



Get the Look: Shown here are Sorbet violas and Crystal Bowl pansies.

BUY

Choose a favorite pumpkin (we like the flat-bottomed Fairytale) and then pick up violas, pansies, red and green leaf lettuce, thyme, and rosemary.

MAKE

Clean pumpkin with a Clorox wipe, cut hole in top, and scoop. Line with aluminum foil or a plastic bag, fill three-quarters full with potting soil, and plant.

DISPLAY

Use as a centerpiece or on a buffet. Place on a trivet to protect furniture. Once the party is over, move to a bright window or outside by the front door.

TRANSPLANT

After a week or so, lift arrangement from pumpkin and replant in a pot or the ground to enjoy through spring. Feed with an all-purpose fertilizer (10-2-8). *
