The Newest Member: Cool Wave™

- Joining the Wave family of easy, spreading color, Cool Wave[™] pansies deliver the same easy-care, long-lasting color as Wave petunias.
- Cool Wave pansies meet gardeners' needs for extended cool-season color by exhibiting superior overwintering hardiness in southern climates up to Zone 5 (-20 to -10 degrees Fahrenheit minimum) and returning in spring earlier than other pansies.
- > Cool Wave is available in yellow, frost, white and violet wing, and as a mixture.







Cool Wave[™] and Plentifall[®]

- Cool Wave [™] pansies have a slightly larger flower size and more vigorous spreading habit than the original Plentifall [®] pansies introduced in 2010, so the plants will fill baskets faster and provide more ground coverage.
- The original three Plentifall colors white, lavender blue and purple wing will be replaced with improved Cool Wave white and Cool Wave violet wing. Cool Wave yellow and Cool Wave frost will maintain the improved Plentifall characteristics introduced in 2011.













Flutterby™


- ➤ Flutterby[™] buddleia provides compact, season-long spreading and mounding color
