### Zinnia (*Zahara*)

Superior disease tolerance makes Zahara an excellent choice in the landscape. These heat-loving plants have very low water needs and are outstanding in sunny, hot and dry conditions. This all-around winner assures care-free, season-long shows in landscapes and containers.

Plant in Full Sun.

### Petunias

Shock Wave blooms in a tight and consistent habit with strong branching to deliver the quickest fill in hanging baskets of any spreading petunia. These petite-flowered, mounded plants performs equally well in small spaces, containers and mixed combos.

Plant in Full Sun

Height 10"-15" Spread 30"-36".



**Spiraea Albiflora**(*Snowmound*)

Snowmound is an attractive woody ornamental that blooms throughout July and August. This Spiraea has bright white flowers in rounded or flat clusters. Excellent shrub for foundation or border planting and performs well in full sun or partial shade. Easy to care for and requires only light pruning once established. It blooms on new wood so the ideal time to prune is in early spring.

Plant in Full to Partial Sun

Height 2'; Spread 2'

Hardy in Zones 3-8
