Innovation Center to present new findings at IDFA's Dairy Sustainability Symposium

WASHINGTON — The Innovation Center for U.S. Dairy will kick off the International Dairy Foods Association (IDFA) Dairy Sustainability Symposium May 25 with an update on the U.S. Dairy Sustainability Commitment and progress made on initiatives to reduce the dairy industry's carbon footprint and build business value.

The Dairy Sustainability Symposium will be held May 25-26 at The James Hotel in Chicago.

The center's presentation will highlight the industry's scientific research efforts including life cycle assessments for fluid milk and cheese, and how these

findings will benefit the entire dairy industry. Speakers from the center will include Ying Wang, director of research, and Gail Barnes, vice president of technology and packaging. Barnes will be joined by industry experts who will discuss energy efficiency and best practices.

The discussion also will introduce a new sustainability initiative that responds to the growing interest and activity in sustainability reporting and product score carding.
