

Deskrun v1.0

(intended for use with Dropper)

Deskrun is a window that pops up and allows you to run another program. This seems useless at first, because you first have to run Deskrun-at that point, you could go ahead and launch the program you really want to use. But, if you have Dropper (a really neat, useful, and FREE program that allows you to leave the icons of any program on your desktop, ready to run) Deskrun actually finds a use. Dropper provides quick access to the programs you use most, but by dropping Deskrun onto your Dropper desktop, you can have quick access to the programs you use least.

Once Deskrun is activated, you will see its main window showing a list of available programs, starting with your Windows directory. Double-click on directory names, or click on a directory name and then click OK, to change directories. Double-click a program, or click a program and then click OK, to run that program. To leave Deskrun without running any other program, click Cancel. If you hold down either the Shift or Control keys while you double-click a program, you can pass a command line to that program.
