Bitmap Changer is a small program that will allow you to easily change the background bitmap of Windows 3.10. You can choose from a filelist of .BMP and .RLE files. You can even preview the file before you change it permenantly.

USING THIS PROGRAM:

To use this program you just either double-click on the filename of your choice or you can drag the file from the file-list to the change button or you can click on the filename and then click the change button.

To preview the image you can either drag the filename either to the preview command button or to the preview box located at the bottom of the form or you can click on the filename and then click the preview button.
