#### Sheet1

Tax Estimator can give you an accurate "estimate" of your federal tax. While accurate unofficial tax rates were used and the formulas sound, the bottom line amount is only a "ballpark" estimate and can not take the place of your tax accountant's knowledge and experience.

Tax Estimator is a spreadsheet prepared in Lotus 1-2-3 release 2.4. It should be compatable with all Lotus 1-2-3 releases 2.x and 3.x. In addition, it should import to other spreadsheet programs (Excel,etc.).

This spreadsheet has the same information as the text files: Read1st.bat, Instruct.txt, Tips.txt, Warranty.txt, and Register.txt.

# INSTRUCTION:

- 1) Enter the correct filing status so that proper tax rates are used.
- 2) Income and tax withholdings may be entered off your paycheck totals.
- 3) Entering the GROSS amount and the number of times paid in one year OR just enter your annual salary (but not both methods).
- 4) Adjustments to income are alimony paid, IRA/SEP contributions, etc.
- 5) Enter the number of exemptions (include yourself, spouse, and kids).
- 6) The standard deduction is automatic based on the filing status, BUT if you itemize, then enter that amount instead of the standard ded.
- 7) Finally, (if nothing changes and you thought of everything) you will have a tax refund or payment that should be a good ESTIMATE of what your final 1040 form will say.

- 1) Press escape and save your worksheet (so you can update any changes).
- 2) Fine tune the figures as close to reality as possible (tax amounts can change significantly, if your figures are off by many \$100's).
- 3) It is probably best to be conservative (overestimate on income and

underestimate on deductions or tax payments).

- 4) Don't forget to adjust for pay raises during the year.
- 5) If you are unsure about itemizing, go with the standard deduction.
- 6) Adjustments to income are good to reduce income, while tax credits are even better because they are a dollar-for-dollar tax reduction. Investigate what adjustments and tax credits you may have.
- 7) If you have a tax payment due, you may pay estimated tax payments (paid quarterly) OR you can increase your withholding on the W-4.
