

Name the States

Version 1.0

This program may help you and your kids learn the states and their capitals. It was written in Visual Basic and requires the VBRUN100.DLL library to work. Everybody should have this file by now; if you don't, it's available on most BBSs around the country.

The program itself is pretty easy to use. Two levels are available. Level One asks you to name the state that is colored blue on the map. You do this by selecting the right answer in the list box and clicking on the Select button or double-clicking on the correct answer in the list box. The state will turn green if you're right. If you're wrong, the correct answer will be shown and the state will turn red. A new state will then turn blue.

Level Two is a bit harder. After naming the state, you are asked to name its Capital. You select the right answer in the same way. If either of the answers are wrong, the state will turn red. If both are right, the state will turn green.

At any time during the game, you can click on the Score option in the menu bar to see how you've done so far. After all the states have been selected, a score and percentage will be shown. To end the game, select Quit on the menu bar. You can also quit at any time during the game.

This program is offered as shareware. If you use it, please send \$10 to the address below. I will send you the newest version on the disk size of your choice without the introductory Beg Box. Please include your address and disk preference when you write. Also include any suggestions for improvement. I have a few ideas in mind which will be worked into later versions if enough response is generated.

In closing, let me state that this program works on my system and should work on yours. If it doesn't, let me know and I'll try to fix it. I am in no way responsible for any problems that it may cause.
