Missouri State Information— 1) **Scholarship Deadlines** -- January 15, 2013. Students must submit their online application for admission by midnight or have their paper copy application postmarked on or before January 15th. Student can submit their housing contracts for the 2013 academic year starting in January. Housing assignments will begin to be made in April and will continue every month until August.
