SmallMagic is in eight colours so Kickstart 2.0+ is needed in order to open a wb in at least 3 planes.

In order for the icons to be proportioned properly a resolution must be used in which the pixel ratio is about 1:2. Examples are:

-Pal/NTSC Hires NoLace (Overscan)
-Pal/NTSC SuperHires Laced (Overscan)
-Super72 NoLace
