Key Features:

• New Pacific Theater aircraft. In "Combat Flight Simulator 2," players can choose to pilot a variety of American and Japanese aircraft, each accurately representing its historical counterpart. Players can fly the deadly single-engine American Vought F4U-1A Corsair, one of the most feared planes of the era, otherwise known as the "ensign eliminator" or take to the skies in the A6M2 Zero, the

- Japanese fighter that dominated the Pacific with its 20 millimeter cannons and lithe maneuverability.
- Realistic aircraft flight models. Rendered in meticulous detail, the aircraft featured in "Combat Flight Simulator 2" are four times more graphically detailed than those in the original game. Each aircraft featured in "Combat Flight Simulator 2" is based on extensive research and detailed "Flight Simulator" models, a program recently selected for a U.S. Navy training program for its unparalleled realism. Planes feature their own unique flight model, performance style and detailed cockpit. Players can watch the Corsair's wings fold on the aircraft carrier pitching deck as they land with a bone-dry fuel tank.

Players can fly in close and see the bullet damage and broken wings of their defeated enemy.
- Harder and smarter fighting. Players can take advantage of their wingmen's improved artificial intelligence and dog-fighting abilities, issue orders and get feedback on their status. When wingmen can't help, players can sit back and enjoy the new bailout sequences.
- **Graphical mission editor.** Creating and modifying missions is easier than ever with a full-featured, graphical mission editor and campaign builder the same tool used by the game's designers to create the battles featured in "Combat Flight Simulator." Add-on developers and enthusiasts can take advantage of this tool to expand the range of missions they can fly in the PTO or European Theater.
