- A Microsoft mouse or compatible pointing device is required to operate Greetings 2001
- PCs must already have Internet access in order to use Greetings 2001's Internet functions

- An audio card with headphones or speakers is required to enjoy Greetings 2001's sound features
- A microphone is required for voice recording
