SYDNEY, March 2009 - As James Grayson, the hero of Resistance: Retribution™ for PSP™ (PlayStation®Portable) from Sony Computer Entertainment Australia (SCE Aust), breaks new ground in taking the fight back to the Chimera, the game itself will break new ground with two special features linking it to Resistance 2™ for PLAYSTATION®3 (PS3™) that give players even more new experiences and choices in how they play. 'Infected Mode' and 'Resistance: Retribution Plus' have been engineered by developers Sony Bend to combine the power of PSP and PS3 into a Chimera-fighting experience that goes well beyond what most shooter titles deliver.

Infected Mode allows owners of Resistance: Retribution on PSP and Resistance 2 on PS3 to 'infect' Retribution with new character abilities, weapons, military intelligence and a modified storyline in which Grayson is injected with a mysterious serum. The mode lets you choose how you want to play: the extra storyline can be played on PSP for Resistance action on the go - or on PS3 for a big-screen view of the action. Infected mode is activated by connecting PSP to Resistance 2 on your PS3 with a USB cable and selecting 'Infect your PSP' on the Resistance 2 options menu.

Resistance: Retribution Plus is a brand-new function that lets you control Grayson with a DUALSHOCK®3 Wireless Controller, giving players a new style of gameplay thanks to the Wireless Controller's dual analogue sticks and vibration technology. It's enabled by linking PSP to PS3 and allows players to get maximum gameplay from Resistance: Retribution at home or on the move.

As well as these great new functions, Resistance: Retribution will also feature all the frantic gameplay and innovative features that players expect in a Resistance title: a gripping narrative, ten different enemy types including the fearsome Cloven, social, eight-player multiplayer play with five game modes including Team Deathmatch and Capture the Flag plus an advanced targeting system developed specially for the game's PSP-friendly third-player format.
